WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Phillies Baseball Academy Players may bring their own helmets if they wish. We have size specific helmets for those campers who don't bring their own.

The official Phillies Baseball Academy uniform is a Phillies Baseball Academy tech tee and a Phillies hat assigned by color for each division. Your camper will receive these on their first morning at camp. Players must arrive to camp in their washed tech tee and hat each day.

Phillies Baseball Academy Players may bring their own bat if they wish. We have plenty for those who do not choose to bring one.

It is preferred that each camper wear baseball pants to camp each day. Shorts are permitted on extremely hot days.

It is preferred that each camper wear cleats with rubber or plastic soles (no metal spikes). Campers should bring sneakers in case rain moves camp inside.



Sunglasses and batting gloves are permitted at camp.

CAMP DIVISIONS

Each camper will receive a Phillies hat in their division color.

Four divisions offer boys & girls the ability to continue developing their baseball skills and take their game to the next level.









WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP (CONT'D)

All Phillies Baseball Academy players should have a backpack clearly labeled with the following items inside on a daily basis.

All personal items must be labeled with the player's full name.

Drinks

It is important that our campers stay hydrated, and we encourage our campers to drink water throughout the day. Please ensure they hydrate at night as well. Our Coaching Staff will offer frequent reminders and give opportunities for water breaks during the camp day.

Campers should bring their own filled water bottle each day. We will have water stations available all day to refill them.

Health & Safety

Safety is our #1 priority, and all campers are required to have an updated physician's or health care practitioner's signature before the 2024 camp season begins (valid from May 2023). Updated childhood immunization records will be required for all campers.

Lunch & Snacks

Campers should bring a lunch and refreshment (marked with their name and team name) in either a cooler or an insulated thermos bag with ice pack. Gum is not permitted at camp.



Sunscreen

Apply sunscreen in the morning before camp and use a waterproof or water-resistant sunscreen with SPF 30+.

Medical Team

A Certified Athletic Trainer is on-site at each location to assist our campers when needed.

Drop-Off & Pick Up

Our Drop-Off & Pick-Up process is designed to be safe, easy and convenient. Our Coaching Staff will be there when you pull up and will open the car door.

Parents/Caregivers should remain in their vehicles at all times.

For late drop-off, early pick-up, absent camper, or other questions, please call the camp phone. Please contact us prior to 1:30pm for early pick-up.

Visiting Camp

Visitors must call ahead and be pre-approved by the Manager and/or Camp General Manager.

It is our goal to assist camp families in contacting other camp families while respecting and maintaining each family's privacy and confidentiality.
